



2013 Bacigalupi Vineyard Zinfandel Russian River Valley

A textured, spicy and balanced Russian River 'Old Vine' Zinfandel.

Sourced from a one-acre parcel of the famed Bacigalupi Vineyard, these head pruned old vines date back prior to 1950 with an estimated age of 80-90 years. Notoriously difficult to farm, this heritage vineyard site is a treasure.

A nearly perfect vintage for Zinfandel, 2013 was characterized by dry, warm days and cooling nights resulting in over two tons produced from this one-acre parcel.

After a rigorous sorting process, the zin was de-stemmed to T-Bins and gently hand punched down one time per day to minimize tannin and extraction. The resulting wine was sent to 100% neutral barrels for 10 months of which five made the final cut for the finished wine. Three percent Petite Sirah added for color and complexity.
